RESEARCH

Key area of interest

My research area of interest spans around: HIV care, conflict and health, contemporary and alternative medicine (CAM), commercial and social determinants of health (SDoH), universal health coverage, and *One Health* approach around neglected tropical diseases (NTDs). I have methodological expertise in mixed methods.

Research skills and experiences

I have produced important knowledge in my key area of interest mainly in HIV and conflict & health which influences policy actors. I have had 119 career publications (88 in Q1), a trending track record with publishing high impact papers (an average of 13 papers per year since completion of my PhD) averaged of 2.95K career citations per year. Delivering projects to deadlines, I was awarded a total 1.5 million Australian dollars and my biggest grant (in terms of amount and funding period) so far was AUD 639,750 for five years which I won as a sole applicant. I am involved in several research skills—team leader; reviewer for major global grant-giving funding bodies and research councils; ethics panel member; and (guest) editor and reviewer for reputable journals and conference abstracts. I am co-supervising 9 PhD students.

In my career research, I employed: (a) nominal group techniques, systematic reviews and meta-analyses, cluster randomized trial, prospective and retrospective cohort, case control, cross-sectional, and qualitative study designs and; (b) online, record/registry-based data extraction, and face-to-face qualitative in-depth interviews and primary survey data collection techniques; (c) descriptive and inferential statistics comprising ANOVA, linear regression, logistic regression (binary, multinomial and complex), cox regression, meta-analysis, non-parametric tests and conjoint analysis, and thematic framework analyses and content analysis. In addition to through publications and conference presentations, I have disseminated my research findings/data through commentaries, official reports, policy briefs, opinion pieces or viewpoints, interviews with televisions or radios, and community (ordinary) meetings. I use R, SPSS, NVivo, Rev Man, and Covidence softwares. I have also other research skills such as dealing with vulnerable population.

I have networks and contacts, and collaboratively work with relevant experts from the following organizations: all major universities in Australia; London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, Lancaster University and King's College London in UK; Columbia University, Eastern Virginia Medical School, University of Wisconsin Madison, Medical University of Southern Carolina, and University of Minnesota Medical school in USA; Jimma University, Mekelle Universities, Tigray Health Research institute and Tigray Regional Health Bureau in Ethiopia; and World Health Organization. I work with people across several disciplines comprising Public Health Medicine, Epidemiology, Health Economics, Biostatistics, Mathematic, Sociology and Geography.

I co-convoked/co-hosted big conferences attracting key figures (e.g. former prime minister), leaders (e.g. founder and CEO of a research institutes), policy makers (e.g. Federal ministers and state/regional President), academics, and journalists. I have dealt with non-academic groups such as media, policy makers, and beneficiaries or ordinary community members with from no to high literacy status.
